

Have an ATU system?

Become your own Maintenance Entity.



ATU Maintenance Entity Training

Florida Onsite Wastewater Association (FOWA) will be holding another training session for homeowners to become qualified to maintain their own ATU systems. If you have any question about whether your system is available for this program, just ask!

When & Where

Homeowners must first complete the basic septic training course on November 19th. The class runs from 8am - 6pm, costs \$500, and will be held at the FOWA Training Center located at 5115 State Road 557 in Lake Alfred, FL. After successful completion of the basic system course, homeowners will then complete the 2-hour system specific class, costs \$200, November 20th on their system and pass the exam.

Contractors

Registered septic tank contractors can attend 2-hour system specific classes, \$200 each, on November 20th to become certified as a maintenance entity for the listed systems. Contractors must be in good standing to attend.

Certification

Certification as your own maintenance entity for your ATU system will last for a 5 year period at which time a review will be done on the system and maintenance paperwork. If all appears to be in order, your certification will be renewed for another 5 year period at no charge. If you do not submit paperwork to review or if maintenance has been performed improperly you will lose your certification and will have to retake the courses in order to obtain certification as your own maintenance entity.
